WHAT IS THE ENVIRONMENTS FOR LIVING® PROGRAM?

The *Environments For Living*[®] program is an initiative of TopBuild Home Services, Inc., a TopBuild company. Introduced in 2001, it is the only national, turnkey program of its kind designed to assist builders in constructing energy-efficient homes using the principles of building science—treating the home as an integrated system of systems.

The *Environments For Living* program provides a rigorous set of requirements for home builders who've made a commitment to go the extra mile. The *Environments For Living* program is leading the way in helping builders construct homes that are more energy efficient, comfortable and durable than homes built using conventional methods. The Environments For Living program offers a full range of services for builders including pre-construction plan reviews, inspection services and diagnostic testing, along with building science training, sales training, and marketing assistance in the form of homeowner limited guarantees on comfort and heating and cooling energy use.*

The *Environments For Living* program is product neutral and does not require any specific manufacturer's products. The prescriptive, performance-based program structure was developed with the assistance of nationally recognized experts in the field of building science. The program offers builders different levels of participation; at all levels, homes built to the program's requirements offer distinct advantages over those constructed to meet conventional building code requirements. Information about the program requirements and homeowner features/benefits can be found at www.environmentsforliving.com.

All homes built to the requirements of the *Environments For Living* program also meet the requirements necessary to earn the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) ENERGY STAR.[®] And, homes built to the Platinum energy level of the *Environments For Living* program meet the specifications of the U.S. Department of Energy's Builder's Challenge[®] program.

In 2007, the *Environments For Living Certified Green* program was introduced, combining the building science platform of the original program with additional environmentally beneficial features and benefits, such as indoor water efficiency, appliance and lighting efficiency and indoor environmental quality. It was designed to be compatible with other green building programs nationally and locally. Builders participating in the *Environments For Living Certified Green* program also may choose to participate in the optional ecomaginationSM Homebuilder Program from GE.

There are now more than 130,000 homes across the United States that have been constructed by builders under the *Environments For Living* program.

GUIDANCE FOR SALES AND MARKETING PROFESSIONALS

Before incorporating program information in sales and marketing materials, please take time to review information about the *Environments For Living*[®] program and *Environments For Living Certified Green*[®] program at www.environmentsforliving.com. In the "Builder Benefits and Resources" section, you will find downloadable copies of consumer brochures and other materials that are available to participating builders, which may be useful to you as you plan your sales and marketing initiatives. Please also visit "Program Details and Specs" to see content that will be helpful to you in communicating the program:

Checklist chart

This chart provides an overview of features and benefits that will help you to understand how the program translates to advantages for homeowners. Information is displayed under four categories with four corresponding icons—energy efficiency, durability, indoor environmental quality and water efficiency. The checkmarks indicate which features are included in the *Environments For Living* program and which are included in the *Environments For Living Certified Green* program. Builders participating in the *Environments For Living Certified Green* program are invited to use the four icons in their materials if desired. And, all participating builders are invited to utilize the language in this chart when describing specific program features and benefits.

Regardless of which program a builder chooses, the builder should promote to prospective homebuyers that the features listed on this chart go beyond conventional building codes.

Program requirements

In preparing sales and marketing materials for the program, you should review the "Program Requirements" (available on the *Environments For Living* program's Website) and make sure that your materials are consistent with these specifications.

Guarantee information

You will want to visit the "Our Guarantee" section, to become familiar with the *Environments For Living* program limited guarantees on comfort and heating and cooling energy use.* As more fully explained in the following pages of this document, sales and marketing professionals must follow strict rules when promoting and talking about the limited guarantees. Because it is necessary to point consumers to the **full** guarantee when referencing it in marketing materials, it is important for marketers to know what that content is and where it is located.

The following general rules apply to the *Environments For Living*[®] program and the *Environments For Living Certified Green*[®] program marks:

- 1. Always spell the mark properly. The "F" in "For" is always upper-cased.
- 2. Distinguish the Environments For Living mark and Environments For Living Certified Green mark by using italics.
- 3. Use the registration symbol [®] the first time the "*Environment For Living*" name appears prominently on a document page or Web page. The [®] symbol should be repeated on first reference for each page thereafter. When referencing the *Environments For Living Certified Green* program the [®] symbol always follows "Green". For example:
 - The Environments For Living® program...
 - The Environments For Living Certified Green® program...
- 4. Always use the mark as an adjective followed by a lower-cased noun, preferably "program." For example:
 - The Environments For Living program...
 - An Environments For Living home...
 - The Environments For Living requirements...
- 5. Never use the mark in the possessive, or as a noun. For example:
 - Wrong (possessive): Environments For Living's program requirements...
 - Correct: The Environments For Living program's requirements include...
 - Wrong (noun): Environments For Living is a program that requires...
 - Correct: The Environments For Living program requires...
- 6. When using marks that you do not own, identify proper ownership. For example:
 - Environments For Living is a registered service mark of TopBuild Home Services, Inc.
- 7. Never use the mark in a manner that implies either the *Environments For Living* program or TopBuild Home Services has participated in, approved or endorsed the design or construction of homes built to the program requirements.

- 8. Sponsors of the program should never use the mark in a manner that implies use of any particular product is required under the program.
- 9. Do not separate, cut-and-stack or otherwise alter the mark's appearance.
- 10. Do not attach the mark to another logo or tagline.
- 11. Do not recreate or otherwise imitate the mark in another type/font.
- 12. Do not incorporate new colors, text, graphics or other icons into the mark.
- 13. Participating builders and sponsors are solely responsible for any use of the mark by them or their marketing agencies and other representatives.
- 14. TopBuild Home Services must approve all advertising, marketing or other promotional use that includes the mark before publication. Materials should be submitted to your program contact with ample time for review.

Environments For Living[®] homes and *Environments For Living Certified Green*[®] homes are issued limited guarantees from TopBuild Home Services, Inc. on comfort and heating and cooling energy use.* The limited guarantees are provided to builders so they can be presented to homeowners at closing.

By providing homeowners with limited guarantees on comfort and heating and cooling energy use, builders can offer a tangible demonstration to homebuyers that they have committed to building homes to a higher standard.

Special care must be taken to accurately communicate the *Environments For Living* program guarantees. In most marketing materials, it is not feasible to include the full guarantee, which can be found at www.environmentsforliving.com. Therefore, all mentions of the guarantees or "guaranteed" performance in marketing materials must be asterisked and footnoted by the following statement:

First reference:

Subsequent-page references:

* Please see the guarantee for complete details and limitations.

The disclaimer statement must be included on each page that mentions the guarantees. Every reference using any variation of the word "guarantee" must be asterisked and footnoted by the disclaimer statement.

Condensed guarantee description

The program Web site (www.environmentsforliving.com) contains the full guarantee, which consumers can download to view it in the context of the actual guarantee that is presented to new home buyers. In addition, the following condensed description of each limited guarantee appears on the Web site and other materials. Builders may utilize this condensed description in marketing materials; however, because neither this nor any other condensed description is the full guarantee, the disclaimer still must be used to direct consumers to the complete language.

Heating & Cooling Energy Use Limited Guarantee*

TopBuild Home Services guarantees the original homeowner that the energy used to heat and cool the home (as calculated in the account analysis) will not exceed the guaranteed usage listed on the front of the limited guarantee, subject to the terms of the limited guarantee. Since this is a limited guarantee of energy use and not cost, any reference to dollar amounts is strictly an estimate and actual costs will vary with the cost of energy.

Comfort Limited Guarantee*

TopBuild Home Services guarantees the original homeowner that the temperature at the location of the thermostat in the home will not vary more than +/- 3 degrees from the temperature at the center of any conditioned room within that thermostat zone. If the home has a room that does not meet this limited comfort guarantee, TopBuild Home Services will reasonably assist your builder to identify the reason(s) for the temperature variance and reasonably coordinate with your builder to have it make changes or modifications to your home.

WRITING AND TALKING ABOUT THE LIMITED GUARANTEES*

It is important that builders and their representatives accurately describe the program guarantees when communicating information about the *Environments For Living*[®] program and *Environments For Living Certified Green*[®] program. In addition to properly including the disclaimer statement, the following details must be presented correctly.

• Energy used for heating and cooling—not "whole house"

Builders must make it clear that the heating and cooling energy use guarantee pertains to energy used for heating and cooling—not whole-house energy use, or the entire energy bill. The reason for this is that neither the builder nor TopBuild Home Services can anticipate how much energy the homeowner will use for other purposes. For example:

Buyers of XYZ Builder homes receive a guarantee on the amount of energy used for heating and cooling.*	Buyers of XYZ Builder homes receive a guarantee on monthly energy.
	Buyers of XYZ Builder homes can expect lower energy costs—guaranteed.
	The <i>Environments For Living</i> program guarantees the homeowner's energy bill.

• Energy amount—not "cost"

In addition, it is important to communicate that the heating and cooling energy use guarantee is provided for the amount of energy—not the cost of energy. However, in order to communicate the approximate average monthly cost to heat and cool their home to homeowners, the heating and cooling energy use limited guarantee includes a dollar estimate of the average monthly cost to heat and cool the home based on the current local utility rates. The dollar estimate is based only on the utility rates and does not include taxes, surcharges, or other fees charged by the utility provider. No marketing, advertising, or other promotional materials (including yard signs) shall state or imply that the estimated average monthly dollar amount is guaranteed. The builder shall not refer to the estimated average monthly dollar amount in any signage or other marketing, advertising, or other promotional materials without TopBuild Home Services' prior review and written approval.

There are many ways to effectively communicate the advantages of participation in the *Environments For Living*[®] program and the *Environments For Living Certified Green*[®] program—and how it can benefit homeowners. In order to do this accurately, it helps to keep in mind who does what: The program offers prescriptive techniques and requires certain performance metrics as a condition of third-party certification and issuance of homeowner limited guarantees.* The builder, on the other hand, is responsible for following the program requirements, and for the overall design and construction of the home. When including information in sales and marketing materials, care should be taken not to attribute things to the program that are beyond the actual scope of the program, or beyond the supportable claims of the program.

· State program claims and program benefits accurately.

When mentioning requirements of the *Environments For Living* program, or features and benefits that are a result of fulfilling the program requirements, be careful not to attribute claims to the program that are the builder's own claims or are otherwise not supportable.

When including information about the *Environments For Living*[®] program in marketing materials, participating builders should follow the following style rules:

• Capitalization and punctuation

Always capitalize all words of the program name (the *Environments For Living* program) but do not capitalize the "p" in "program," or any other generic noun that follows the name.

When including information about the limited guarantee(s) in marketing materials, builders may upper-case the names of the guarantees for emphasis. For example: Comfort Guarantee, or the *Environments For Living* Comfort Guarantee.

When mentioning both guarantees, builders may find it helpful to use an ampersand to join the words "heating" and "cooling." For example: the Heating & Cooling Energy Use and Comfort Guarantees.

• TopBuild Home Services, Inc.

Builders shall state in their marketing materials that the program is an initiative of Masco Home Services, Inc. TopBuild Home Services must not be abbreviated to "Masco".
