Designed by leading U.S. Building Science experts, the *Environments For Living* program helps builders construct higher performing, energy-efficient homes that can meet requirements for the EPA's ENERGY STAR label, potentially receive the U.S. Department of Energy's Building America designation, and qualify for tax credits under the Energy Policy Act of 2005. The *Environments For Living* program utilizes techniques of Building Science to help reduce energy loss, including a continuous air barrier, efficient heating and cooling systems, and tight ductwork.

In addition, the program establishes requirements for tight construction, improved thermal systems, right-sized HVAC systems, fresh air ventilation, balanced air pressure, internal moisture management, and combustion safety. To help builders meet the program requirements, a plan review is performed for each new model, and some homes are performance-tested and evaluated through random testing by trained and certified contractors. Depending on the level of the builder's participation in the program, limited heating and cooling energy use and comfort guarantees are available to homeowners.
