The Environments For Living program earns award for protecting the environment through energy efficiency

Daytona Beach, FL, March 9, 2010 – The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has named the *Environments For Living* program as a 2010 ENERGY STAR® Partner of the Year for its outstanding contribution to reducing greenhouse gas emissions through its work. More than one million American families now live in ENERGY STAR qualified homes.

Last year, Americans with the help of the ENERGY STAR program, saved \$17 billion on their energy bills and reduced greenhouse gas emissions equivalent to those of 30 million vehicles.
